

Once again, the Friends have been generously granted \$6,500 from the EFS Foundation for 2017. This money is applied to sponsoring all reading programs at the library, including related supplies and materials throughout the year.

All grant money received, and every fundraiser the Friends Foundation holds helps to support the library's changing needs.
