



The City of Chicago rose from the ashes of the Fire of 1871 to the remarkable White City of the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition.

Mr. Burnham narrates a slide program detailing the Chicago Fire of 1871, the building of the 1893 World's Columbian Exhibition, and the Chicago Plan of 1909 outlining the development plan for the city.

The famed architect discusses his innovative buildings:
Montauk, Monandnock, Reliance, and the Rookery, and presents the historic Burnham Plan of 1909 advocating sensible city growth asking, "How are we living?"
