Ransom E. Olds, founder of Oldsmobile and the father of the Detroit auto industry, will detail the early auto inventors: Diamler, Benz, Duryea, Olds, Dodge, Studebaker, Hupmobile, Ford, and Stanley. It was Olds who started the assembly line (not Ford), the parts supplier system, and schooled many men who later started their own companies.

He will also talk about the history of auto racing, and the first African-American women to buy a car and become a millionaire selling beauty and hair care products. And, of course, the famous Burma Shave signs along the highways that gave a boost to Burma Shave sales and put a smile on many faces.


